Marin Rod and Gun Club Temporary Rules and Requirements as of May 8th, 2020

The Clubhouse, Lawn, Picnic, and Patio areas remain closed under State and County order.

Members may enter and use the property for the specific purposes of pier fishing, archery, and launching boats, from 11am-7pm daily.

Significant additional limits, rules, and restrictions are in place at this time.

Please review the details below.

If you feel unwell, show any symptoms of fever, cough, etc.: please do not endanger other members and their families with your presence at the club.

If you feel sick, stay at home.

Access Limitations:

Access to the club is restricted to 11:00AM to 7:00PM daily. No activity at the club is permitted outside of these operating hours.

You must have a mask or face covering to enter the property. Masks or face coverings MUST be worn in all common areas, and when entering and exiting the pier through the pier keeper house area.

We are limiting the number of people at the club to a total of 25 on the pier and 25 on the archery range (for members with Range Passes). Each member will be limited to one guest. The club's bartenders will be enforcing these occupancy limits.

The Archery Range, Fishing Pier and Boat Ramp are the only accessible areas. The clubhouse, lawn, picnic, patio and other social areas are strictly off limits for the safety of our members and guests, and will remain closed until state and county restrictions are lifted.

Social Distancing and Hygiene

Maintain social distancing!

Stay as far apart as possible: a minimum of 6 feet apart at all times.

Four sanitization stations are available: in each clubhouse restroom, on the pier, and at the salad shack adjacent to the archery range. The clubhouse restrooms will be open and accessible from the outside of the clubhouse. Stations are equipped with soap, water, paper towels, and hand sanitizer. Please do not remove supplies.

Enforcement

The Bar Staff will be ensuring member compliance with these rules during club hours. Refusal to comply with any and all regulations will result in a warning. Repeat violators will be asked to leave the property.

Common Courtesy

- If needed please limit your time at the club to allow access by others. Be aware of occupancy limits and be thoughtful of those who may be waiting to access.
- Please pack out all garbage and recycling. Do not use the receptacles at the club.
- Do not remove any hand sanitizer or other hygiene supplies.

Additional Notes

- We will not have bait or shopping carts available on the pier.
- The front parking lot should be prioritized for handicapped parking. When possible, please park in the rear parking lot to reduce the appearance of crowding.
- Do not enter the Square on the pier. Repairs need to be done and this area is restricted.
- The Club By-laws, pier and archery range rules, and all other rules apply during this shelter in place. Please observe all posted notices.
